CMAP Transportation Committee Special Meeting: CTA Redline Extension ETIP Funding Ordinance

Good morning, CMAP Transportation Committee Members, CTA Administrators and fellow transportation planners.

The Redline Extension TIF Coalition is a regional planning, public policy, economic development and civic engagement initiative working to ensure equity in transportation, infrastructure and green futures.

The Redline Extension TIF Coalition wishes to register our support for today's ordinances to advance Carbon Reduction Programming and Workforce Development Funding.

We appreciate action by the CMAP Transportation Committee to hold this critically important special meeting. This meeting adds value to the regional hope of obtaining this Fall season a Federal Full Funding Agreement from the Federal Department of Transportation.

As the Transportation Committee and staff are aware, time is money. The quicker, CTA secures its Full Funding Agreement, the quicker we can secure other necessary permits and supplies to contain hard and soft costs. Cost Containment is paramount!

With this support, it's our hope that CMAP and CTA planners would revisit ways to strengthen and improve upon Transit Oriented Development (TOD) concepts at the four (4) stations. We believe the increased cost of the Redline Extension project (now \$5.3 Billion) should trigger an expanded scope of redevelopment options via for each public dollar spent, a six (6) fold of private investment is generated.

Therefore, we request that CMAP and CTA pursue TOD and Workforce Solutions initiatives in FY 2025-26. In addition, we wish to encourage CTA to consider hosting a Public Meeting on its Station Area activities surrounding the Railroad Operations by Union Pacific Railroad via Railroad Yard at 121st street.

To this end, we urge full support of today's action to fund the CTA with Carbon Reduction Programming and Workforce Solutions grants. We look forward to celebrating this Fall season upon the receipt of the Federal Full Funding Agreement.
