Subject: CMAQ, CRP, and TAP-L Project Change Requests

Action Requested: Approval

Project sponsors requested consideration of changes to eight (8) projects. Three project requests are not being brought forward for consideration. The three requests that aren't being recommended for committee approval— two from Metra (18-25-0020 and 16-25-0011) and one from Park Forest (07-25-0007)— were awarded funds in the new FFY 2026-2030 program and are requesting schedule changes, however, the new program is not official until October 1, 2025.

The five (5) sponsors' requests that are being presented for consideration are included in the meeting packet. Staff recommends approval of the five requests. In addition, staff approved two requests administratively, which are outlined in the administrative section. Below is a summary of the impacts of the changes on the fiscal constraint of the three respective programs.
